'Flu Vaccinations for Children



Please note, 'flu vaccinations are available for all children aged 2,3 and 4 this year.

Children are offered a nasal vaccination rather than injection. Having the 'flu vaccination not only protects your child against flu, but will also result in less time off nursery/school and less infection transmitted to other family members. There is a local GP working for the out of hours service 24 hours a day. If patients need to access a GP out of hours they need to ring 111.

Appointment Length

Please note that appointments with a GP are for 10 minutes,. If you think that you require longer than this time, please inform the receptionist of this and ask for a double appointment.
